Augustins Museum

The Augustins Museum is the fine arts museum of Toulouse. Housed in a former 14th-century convent in the heart of the city, its large cloister and garden offer visitors a unique atmosphere.

Its collections include exceptional medieval sculptures, numerous large-format paintings from the 17th and 18th centuries, as well as a remarkable series of 19th-century paintings and sculptures. Contemporary art is also present, especially with the Jorge Pardo's installation, a work created specifically to dialogue with the site and the collections.
