Church of Gesù

Located in the heart of the Carmes district, the Church of Gesù is a subtle gem of Toulouse's heritage. Its neo-Gothic architecture, preserved wax-painted decorations, and original stained glass windows give it a distinctive style, making it a unique monument in the city.

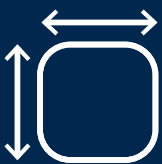
